

Mystery Quilt

Clue Number Two

STEP TWO

Dark fabric – cut two strips measuring $4 \frac{7}{8}$ " by 45" (or length of fabric)

Light fabric – cut two strips measuring $4 \frac{7}{8}$ " by 45" (or length of fabric)

Cut into 16 squares of $4 \frac{7}{8}$ ". Layer one dark square and one light square right side together. Draw a diagonal line on light square. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press open to the dark side. You should have a total of 32 half-square triangles.

NOTE: In a perfect world these segments should measure $4 \frac{1}{2}$ ". However, this is not a perfect world. I would cut one, press it open and measure it before cutting the rest. You may have to square up the segments or sew a slightly narrower seam. (You may also use Thangles)

Combine two units of Step One and two units of Step Two to make a large four-patch as shown below.
