

Mystery Quilt

Clue Number Three

STEP THREE

Dark fabric – cut one strip measuring $4\frac{1}{2}$ " by 45" (or length of fabric)
Cut 4 squares, each measuring $4\frac{1}{2}$ " – set aside

Medium fabric – cut two strips measuring $4\frac{1}{2}$ " by 45" (or length of fabric)
Cut 16 squares, each measuring $4\frac{1}{2}$ " – set aside

Dark fabric – cut 2 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 45"

Light fabric – cut 2 strips measuring $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 45"

Match dark and light strips (right sides together) and sew to make two sets. Cut apart every $21\frac{1}{2}$ " to yield 32 segments. Combine pairs to make 16 four-patches as shown below.

Make a nine patch as follows:

Row 1 – 4 patch + medium square + 4 patch

Row 2 – Medium square + Dark square + Medium Square

Row 3 – 4 patch + medium square + 4 patch
